SECTION VI - Health Hazard Data

Primary Routes of Entry:

Inhalation-YES      Skin-YES      Ingestion-NO

Health Hazards:

Inhalation: Vapor or mist can cause headache, nausea & irritation of the nose, throat and lungs, tightness of the chest and shortness of breath.

Skin Contact: Possible skin sensitizer. Can cause irritation.

Eye Contact: Causes irritation, pain and tearing marked by excess redness and swelling.

Signs and Symptoms of Exposure: Reddening of eyes & skin upon contact. Coughing upon inhalation of vapors.

Medical Conditions Aggravated by Exposure: Chronic respiratory condition. Skin allergies, eczema.

Emergency and First Aid Procedures:

Inhalation: Move subject to fresh air. If not breathing give artificial respiration. Call a physician.

Eye and Skin contact: Flush eyes with large amounts of water for 15 min. Wash affected area with soap & water, if irritation persists see physician. If accidentally ingested-contact physician.

SECTION VII - Precautions for Safe Handling and Use

Released or Spilled: Remove all sources of ignition. Soak up absorbent material. dispose of in accordance with local, state and federal regulation.

Waste Disposal Method: Dispose of in accordance with local, state and federal regulations.

Precautions to be Taken in Handling and Storing: Keep away from children. Do not get in eyes, skin or clothing. Keep container closed when not in use. Wash thoroughly after handling and before eating or drinking. Use with adequate ventilation.

Other Precautions: No eating or drinking should be allowed in the vicinity of this material. Smoking in the same area is strictly prohibited.

Respiratory Protection: Use NIOSH/NOSH approved air respirators, OSHA approved mask for chemical vapors.
